SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

General	If symptoms occur or persist, seek medical advice. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

5.1 Extinguishing media

Suitable extinguishing media: use extinguishing media appropriate to the surrounding fire. Unsuitable media: do not use a solid water jet where it could spread burning material.

5.2 Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

Thermal decomposition may produce carbon oxides and other products of incomplete combustion. Prevent contaminated extinguishing water from entering drains or surface waters.

Avoid contact with eyes and unintended prolonged skin contact. Wear gloves and suitable work clothing. Provide adequate ventilation if aerosols are generated.

6.2 Environmental precautions

Avoid uncontrolled release to drains, surface water, groundwater and soil.

6.3 Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

Contain the spill. Absorb with an inert material, collect in a suitable labelled container and dispose of in accordance with Section 13. Wash residual contamination with water while preventing discharge to drains.

SECTION 7: Handling and storage

7.1 Precautions for safe handling

For professional use. Shake the closed container for 5-10 seconds before use. Use disposable gloves. Avoid contamination of the product and container. Do not eat, drink or smoke while handling. Close the cap securely after dispensing. Use only the manufacturer's specified diluent (Magic Water) or thickener; do not mix with water or unapproved diluents.

7.2 Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Store in the original, tightly closed container in a dry, well-ventilated place at 10-25 °C. Protect from moisture, frost, direct sunlight and high temperatures. Suitable packaging: glass or compatible polymer packaging.

7.3 Specific end use(s)

See Section 1.2. Unopened shelf life: 3 years. Period after opening: 12 months, subject to the labelled expiry date and hygienic handling.
